About the program

Kingdom Care was established in 1997 as a preschool program. In 2002, Kingdom Care was established as a Before and After School Program. In 2007 both programs were combined. The preschool morning program instructs students for academic learning and provides a loving environment for social, emotional, physical and spiritual growth. Afternoon activities include; Bible, Art, Adventure Story, Spanish and Music.

About the Director/ Preschool Instructor

Mrs. Kelly holds a Bachelor's Degree in Education and a second Bachelor's Degree in Psychology with concentration in Childhood Development. She completed her teaching certification through Christian Light Education. Mrs. Kelly taught preschool in the original Kingdom Care founded in Roanoke, Virginia for ages 2-4. Mrs. Kelly taught Pre-Kindergarten at Manassas Christian Academy for two years. She founded and operated a homeschool-tutoring program for students giving full assistance in all academic subjects in a home-based classroom 8am-1pm. Mrs. Kelly is current Director of Kingdom Care After School Programs, a position she has held for twenty years during which time she has given educational assistance to students ages five to ten. Her life's goal is to continuously offer educational insight and guidance to children through curriculum utilization and creative play.

Staff

The preschool staff includes; Assistant Director Alaysia Davis. Ms. Alaysia holds her Associates Degree and is currently at Bowie State majoring in Elementary Education. She has been on staff for 2 years. She will teach the preschool students rotating with Mrs. Kelly and rotate as an after school teacher.

Kingdom Care is accredited as a Service Learning Site for educational credits. Each year, college interns will be present, after background checks. Background information will be sent at the start of the school year on selected students.

Enrollment:

A registration fee of 1 week's deposit per child is required to enroll. This fee may be paid in full or in payments of 1 or 2. In addition, the curriculum cost is due at enrollment (or parents may order it and ship it to their home or here) with paperwork consisting of the emergency form, contract for care, all about me form, immunization records, state health inventory form and permission slip for outings.

TUITION PRICES- 3 days \$225 weekly. Five days \$290 weekly.

Preschool Beginner's Activity Set-\$10

Four workbooks in the Beginner's Activity Series provide practice for three- and four-year-olds in motor skills, hand-eye coordination, and visual comparison. *About Three* has simple exercises in line drawing and visual discrimination. *Bigger Steps* contains more advanced matching and visual comparison exercises. *Color, Cut, and Count* helps the child learn the colors and work with numbers. *Doing My*

Best gives further practice in coloring, counting, matching, and cutting. These workbooks may be bought separately or as a complete set.

Kindergarten I-\$20.50 set

The five Kindergarten 1 Workbooks introduce listening skills, matching, identifying eight primary colors, coloring, tracing and counting and more,

Kindergarten II-\$41 set

Kindergarten II continues in detail the concepts of matching, dot-to-dot, color names, sounds, letter writing, recognizing and writing numbers 1-100, and more. This set includes five workbooks and five supplemental activity books, for a total of ten books

Specific Supplemental Books We Use-\$3.50 Each

Hearing and Helping-Includes practice in hearing initial consonant sounds and rhyming words; understanding words in sentence context, as well as following instructions. Exercises also include examples of families and children helping others.

Inside and Outside-More practice with colors and shapes; counting by 2's and 10's; math concepts, seasons and weather.
